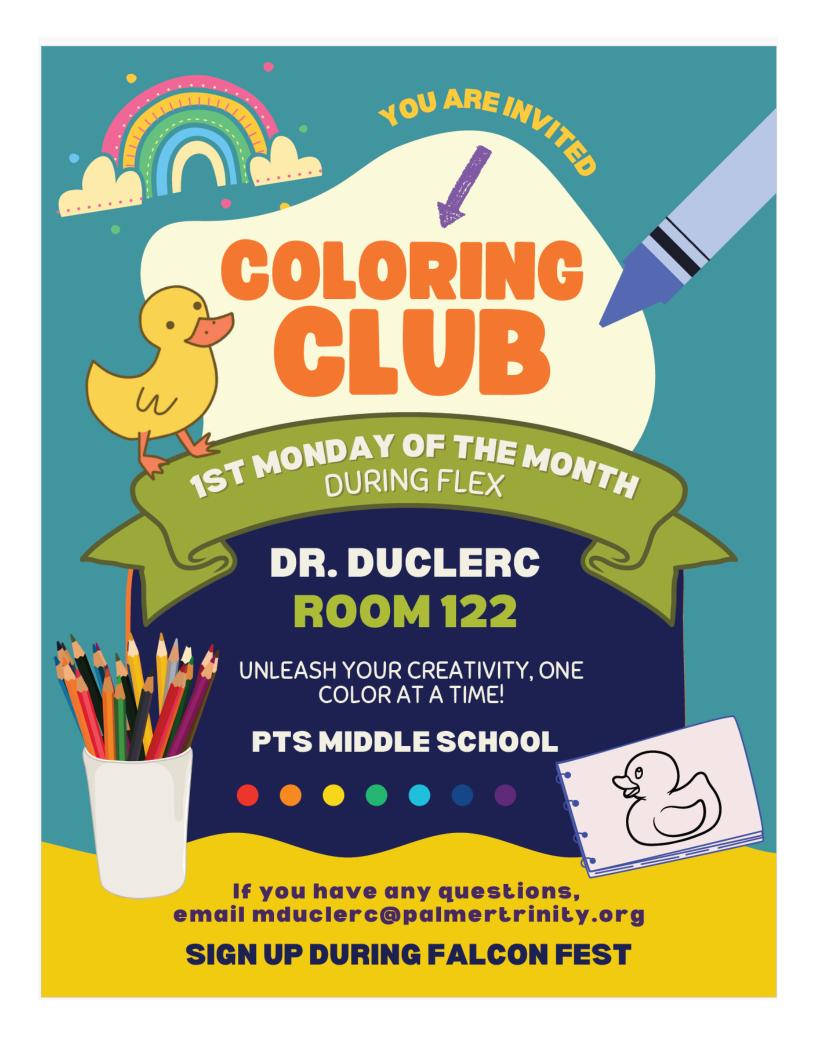

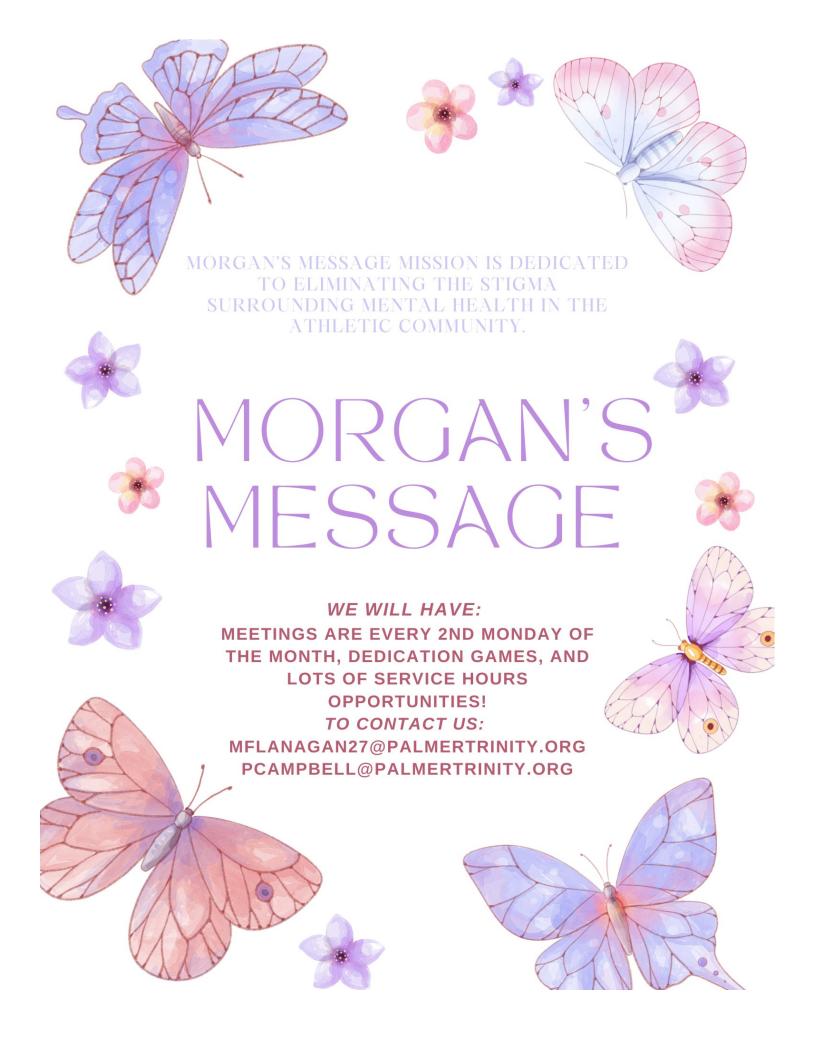
What we do:
