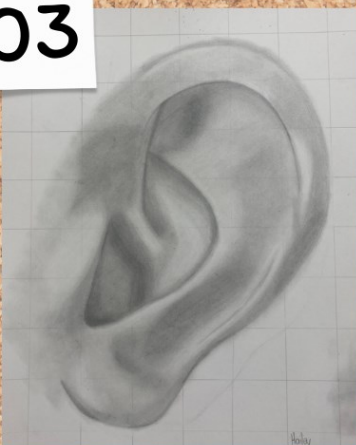
Activities and Requirements

OUR MISSION

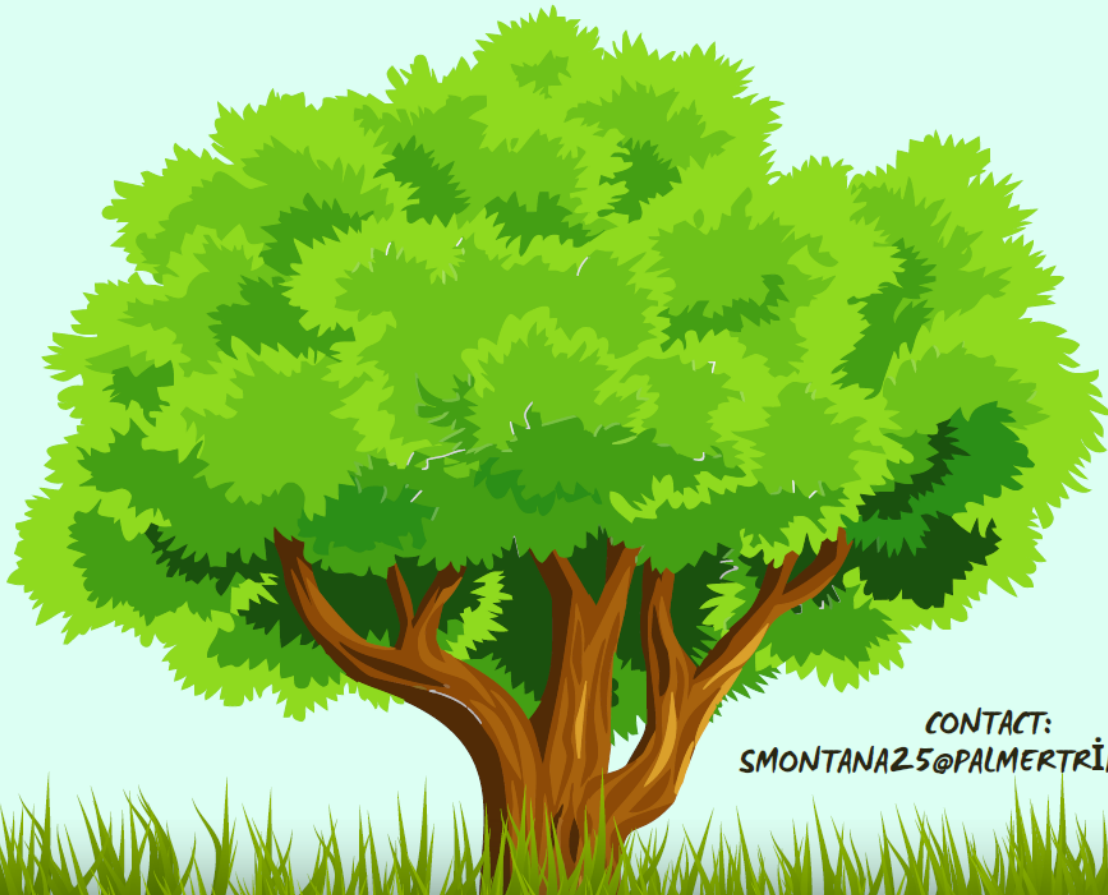
Branches Buddies encourages PTS students to volunteer in Branches Community Centers in all types of activities for underserved children in the community.
